 - A. Projects: Lights-The lights have been looked at but we have not received a quote in dollar amounts yet. Sprinklers- Sprinklers are fixed and running well. A Purchase Order had been encumbered for landscaping so flowers have been planted by some of our AARP people and they have done an excellent job.

New or Existing Grants: Tribal Conference Grant: We have received notification from the Tribal Conference in Portland, Oregon. We have been approved to be a presenter. The only financial help they can give us is (1) One night's lodging for the five staff who were involved in the Tribal Grant, and (2) Waiver the cost of the Conference Registration for the five staff. This leaves flight costs, meal costs, and another night's lodging (approximately \$2,500).
7. Librarian's Report. (1) We are getting some Summer Youth Workers, (2) I have not heard anything else about the World War II exhibit and would anyone like to be on a committee regarding obtaining funding for this project, (3) We are working on budget cutting (Salaries & Utilities are a big concern in the library budget, (4) Author signing May 30th, Stephen Stapleton. His book "Broken Arrow: The First 100 Years, and (5) Library Policies need to be reviewed for part of the State Report. (This will take approximately 20 to 30 minutes). (6) Issues and/or concerns.
