The following items must be submitted as part of the application for a Lot Split.					

1. Three (3) copies of a survey of the property to be split. Survey must be signed and stamped by a

registered surveyor or Professional Civil Engineer licensed in the State of Oklahoma.

- All existing and proposed property lines will be shown;
- All existing buildings and proposed improvements and the setbacks;
- o All adjacent streets wand widths, ROW's, utility easements and access points/easements;
- o Location of any other easements, oil wells, and/or pipelines, or overhead power lines
- 2. Filed Deed of ownership with the Book & Page stamp from the County Clerk
- 3. New deeds that will be signed if the application is approved
- 4. A check payable to the City of Sapulpa (no cash or money orders) for \$45.00 at the time of application
- **5.** The completed and signed copy of this application.

Staff will not accept an application unless all required documentation and the application fees are submitted.
